The Warranty program is a team effort on the part of the Conklin Company Inc. and your roofing contractor. It exists because these two parties have confidence in each other's product and service.

And because of this spirit of trust and teamwork, it's possible to guarantee you a leak-free Conklin roofing system, subject to specific conditions and limitations set forth in the warranty itself.

What the warranty program means to you, the building owner

When your warranty is issued, you have the guarantee of Conklin Company and the contractor that your roof will not leak due to ordinary wear and tear from the elements or from improper application. If any water leakage occurs in the roofing system it will be repaired free of charge to you, subject to the conditions and limitations of the warranty. And that's backed by a company with more than one billion square feet of roofing experience.

How your warranty works

Inspections are key to maintaining and extending the life of any roofing system. Roof inspections by the Conklin Company and contractor are performed after completion of the job. Also, a yearly maintenance inspection must be arranged by the building owner with the contractor.

The role of your contractor in the warranty program

As an independent business owner, your contractor has completed a training program and has met specific requirements.

The contractor's primary role is to supervise the application of the roof systems to meet specifications. But the contractor also has the important responsibilities in the warranty program. Your contractor provides the Conklin Company with written reports of the entire roof installation procedure. This includes a detailed inspection report both before and after application.

The role of the Conklin Company in the warranty program

As the manufacturer of the roof system, the Conklin Company is directly involved in the warranty program.

Before the job can begin, the Conklin Company technical staff evaluates the contractor's written inspection reports. They anticipate potential trouble spots and advise your contractor accordingly. Conklin Company will advise both the contractor and building owner when approval to begin the job has been given. Then, upon completion of the job, a Conklin Company warranty inspector visits your roof. This roofing expert checks that all specifications have been followed and specifications must be met in order for the warranty to be issued.

Once the warranty fees are paid and all the requirements met, the warranty can be issued directly to you from both your contractor and the Conklin Company.

The warranty is fully transferable to a new building owner when certain criteria have been met and written approval has been given by the Conklin Company.
